

**1. Format:**

- Gender requirement -League specific (COED 4-2,5-1,Mens,Womens)
- A minimum of four players is required to avoid forfeiting the game.
- Teams must notify the organizers in advance if they cannot meet the format.

2. Level of Play

- League specific

3. Game Timing:

- League specific-Details in League homepage

4. Substitutions:

- Unlimited substitutions are allowed but must occur during a dead ball.

5. Roof Contact:

- If the ball contacts the roof and stays on the same court, play continues.
- If the ball contacts the roof and crosses into opposing court, it is considered out of play.

6. Serving Rules:

- There is no limit to how many consecutive serves a player may take.

7. Service Line Rule:

- While serving, the server is allowed to touch the back line with one foot, but stepping completely over the line before making contact with the ball will result in a fault.

8. Back Row Attack Violation:

- A back-row player must take off completely behind the attack line when performing an attack hit.
- If any part of their foot touches or crosses the attack line during takeoff, it is considered a back-row attack fault.

9. Self-Refereeing:

- Teams are responsible for self-refereeing their matches.
- Any disputes over calls must be resolved by team captains.
- Teams are allowed to adjust the score if both sides agree to a correction.

10. Submitting Scores:

- The teams must submit the final scores to the organizers immediately after the match.

11. Setup and Score Submission Assistance:

- All teams are expected to bring their own volleyballs, indoor shoes and jerseys.
- Teams must cooperate in maintaining the court and try not to leave any garbage

12. Outdoor Shoe Policy:

- Players are not allowed to wear outdoor shoes on the court.
- Only clean, non-marking indoor court shoes are permitted.

13. Code of Conduct:

- Players are expected to maintain good sportsmanship and respect referees, opponents, and teammates.
